Topics**Node.js**

Node.js is an open source project based on Google Chrome V8 JavaScript Engine. It provides a platform for server-side JavaScript applications running without browsers. The event-driven, non-blocking I/O model makes it lightweight and efficient to use. It also provides several built-in modules to simplify programming, especially for networking applications. There are many more third-party modules that can be easily installed with the built-in npm (node packaged modules) tool to extend Node.js. Node.js is now supported for the IBM i platform.

IBM i Security

It is also said that proponents love the IBM i because it lets them sleep at night, but these days it is security issues that are keeping CIO's up at night.
